UHF in the metro area is tight, still finding pairs for systems.

On Saturday August 31st Jay and I attended the Wisconsin Association of Repeaters (WAR) in Eau Claire. Many of the coordinators in the Midwest are experiencing similar problems with coordination's, new modes band planning, database software and terrain modeling software. Illinois is working with a Linux RF propagation software called signals.

They feel there are some inconsistencies with Radio Mobile's mapping. I did not find any reference to it online, but did find one called Splat. The MRC coordination calls for using Radio Mobile specifically, this would need to be amended in the future if we want to change.

Indiana is working on a online system to manage coordination's. WAR has setup conference calls with the upper Midwest coordination groups to discuss ideas.

WAR is using paypal to process membership dues payments. If we do the same Paypal fees would be \$0.30 + 2.9% per transaction. Need to be a 501c3 to qualify for discounted rates
